

HOW TO COMPLETE:

1) Create a BINGO row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) and read a book for each category.

2) Record the title of the book in each category in the category box.

3) Complete the literature response for ONE of the books that you have read.

4) Turn in your BINGO card with your full name to your homeroom teacher on the first day of school.

5. All participants will receive a special award the first week of school.
